Before this donation, when an unidentified pet was found in HC or in our neighboring communities, we had to take the pet to a local veterinarian or to the Shavano Park pet registry to determine if the animal was micro-chipped. With this tool, we can scan the animal right away. If the animal doesn't have a chip, then we will first check our database to see if the animal is registered. If it isn't then we will send out an email and put up signs in the neighborhood.

Please, register your pet on line. It is easy and takes about 2 minutes to do. A registered pet makes finding the owner easy. Of course, the pet is always very happy to be back to its home.
