

# LOST AND FOUND

## What to do when you've lost or found a pet in Hunters Creek

### LOST A PET:

1. Contact [petfind@hunterscreeksatx.org](mailto:petfind@hunterscreeksatx.org) with the following information: when and where the pet was lost, whether the pet is registered with Hunters Creek, the pet's name, breed, age, and sex, and the owner's name.
2. We will send out an email to a community distribution list describing your animal and how to contact you if found.

#### Other Suggested Methods to Find Your Pet:

3. Create flyers - include the pet's breed, your name, and contact number.
4. Contact local vet clinics.
5. Place an ad in the SA Express newspaper (210-250-3915).
6. Contact Animal Services to see if your pet has been turned in.
7. **Check and post** info for free at [www.SApets.com](http://www.SApets.com). (Great site!)

### FOUND A PET:

1. Bring it into an enclosed area separate from any other animals. (Indoors is suggested in the summer.)
2. Give it water and food, if possible.
3. Check for injuries, and monitor behavior.
4. Contact [petfind@hunterscreeksatx.org](mailto:petfind@hunterscreeksatx.org). Include the following information: where and when you found the animal, the breed, color, sex, the estimated age and weight, and any collars or identifying features.
5. Place an ad in the SA Express newspaper - there is no fee if you've found a pet.
